Jos Boys – Co-director, The DisOrdinary Architecture Project and independent scholar

Gender, housing and care, then and now

The publication *Making Space: Women and the Man-Made Environment* (Pluto Press 1984) by UK-based feminist design collective Matrix is one example of second wave feminists grappling with the intersections between gender, our built surroundings and architectural practices in the 1980s. In this talk, Jos Boys – one of the co-authors of that book, and a founding member of Matrix – uses this work as a 'jumping off' point for exploring how social, spatial and material relations related to gender and housing have changed since then, as well as some of the ongoing shifts in discourses and narratives. She also brings more recent work as a co-director of The DisOrdinary Architecture Project (a platform led by disabled artists to rethink access and inclusion across the built environment) to current framings of care. By engaging with the critical and creative intersections between architectural/housing-based approaches and disability scholarship, arts and activism, Jos will discuss the importance, but also the complexities, of bringing an ethics of care to bear on gender and housing issues.
