- A new player (for you): the client

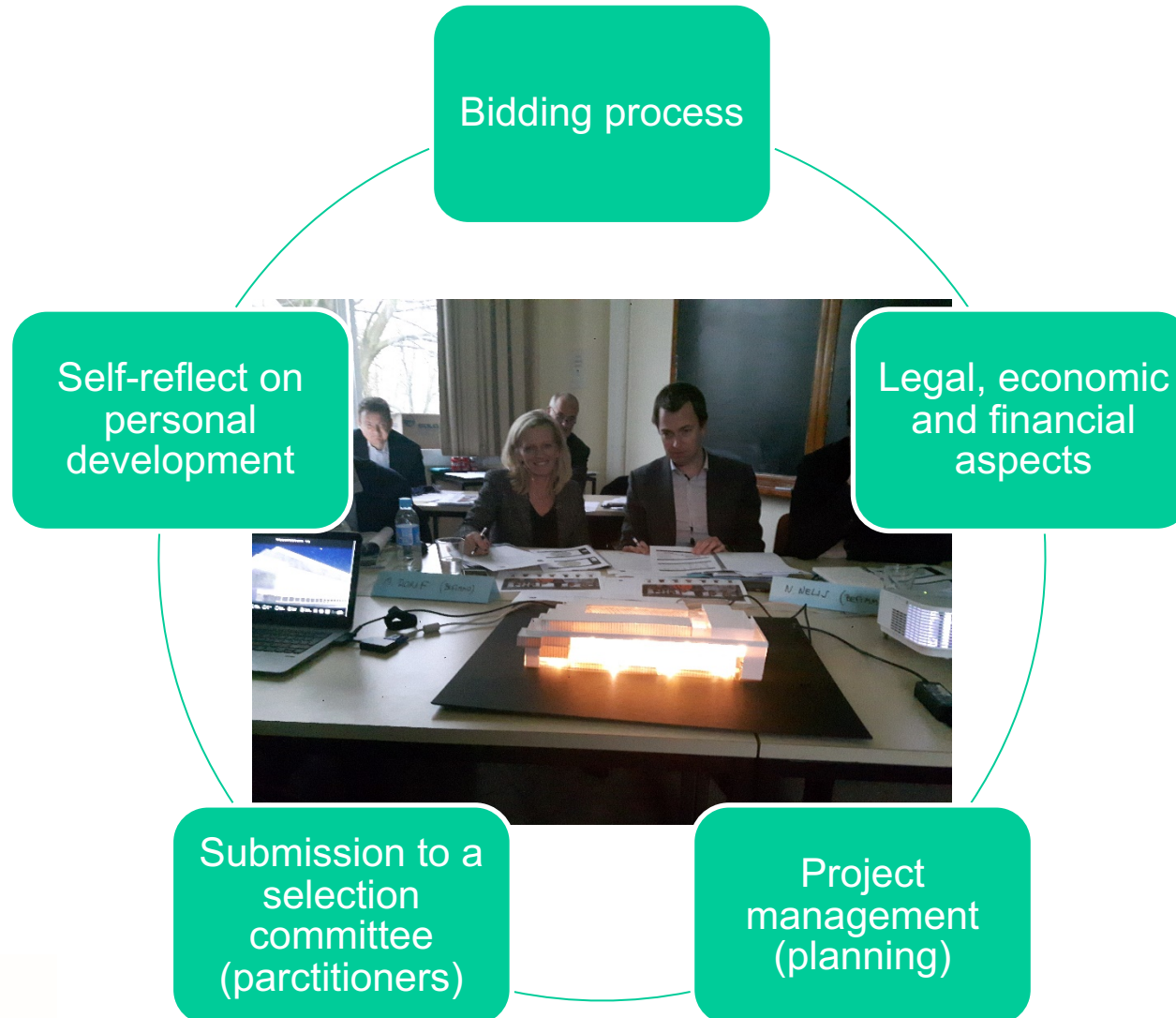
Teamwork
